- A. Jesus prayed the Lord's prayer right after His Farewell Sermon in John 14-16.
- B. Jesus prayed the Lord's prayer right before Calvary in John 19.

4. How did Jesus pray?

- A. Jesus' posture (17:1)
- B. Jesus prayed to the Father (17:1, 5, 11, 21, 24, 25)

5. For what did Jesus pray? Jesus prayed three petitions.

- 1. John 17:1-5 He Prayed for Himself (But not selfishly)**
- 2. John 17:6-19 He Prayed for His Disciples
- 3. John 17:20-26 He Prayed for Us

1. John 17:1-5 Jesus Prayed for Himself

A. In Relationship to God (17:1)

- 1) To do God's will "the hour is come" (2:4, 7:30, 8:20, 12:23, 13:1, 17:1)
- 2) To glorify God

B. In Relationship to People (17:2-3)

- 1) To give eternal life to those the Father had given Him (17:2)
- 2) Eternal life is more than living forever (17:3)

C. In Relationship to God again (17:4-5)

- 1) Jesus glorified God by completing the task (17:4)
- 2) God glorified His Son (17:5)
