

Reading Through God's Word in 2011 (Week 3)

Redemption (The Book of Exodus)

Wednesday, January 19th

Genesis is the Book of Beginnings (Human Race and the Jewish Race in Egypt).

Exodus is the Book of Redemption of Israel from the bondage of Egypt (Exodus 1:1 "and these are the names..."). Redemption has to do with names of individuals, whose names are written in the Lamb's Book of Life.

In *Genesis* there is the Promise of Canaan Land

In *Exodus* there is the Possession of Canaan Land (In between are 400 years, where the Jewish family of 70 multiplied to 2 million in Egypt as prophesied in Gen 15:13 and now need delivering)

"Exodus" means departure or going out:

1. Luke 9:31, The Death of Christ was His exodus
2. 2nd Peter 1:15, The Death of Peter was his exodus
3. In Exodus, The redemption is accomplished through death

1. Israel in Egypt in Slavery (Chapters 1-12)

A. Preparation of the Deliverer (Exodus 1-4)

1. Preparation of Israel in (ch. 1)
2. Preparation of the Deliverer (chs. 2-4)
 - a. Moses birth (2:1-9)
 - b. Moses training (2:10-25)
 - c. Moses call, 5 excuses, and proper response (3-4)

B. Plagues on the Oppressors (Exodus 5-11) Pharaoh asked "Who is the Lord?" in 5:2. Ten plagues later Pharaoh knows who the Lord is.

1. Plagues revealed God. Every plague was a direct attack on an Egyptian god.
 - a. In the first plague, the Nile river or Apis the god of the Nile was defeated
 - b. In the last plague, the firstborn or Isis the goddess who protected the children was

defeated.

2. *Plagues gave Pharaoh an opportunity to believe (Psalm 136:10)*

a. God hardened Pharaoh's heart 10 times (7:3)

b. Pharaoh hardened his heart 8 times (7:22)

2. Israel at the Red Sea in Salvation (Chapters 12-18)

A. *Salvation by Blood (Chapter 12)* The Passover Lamb (1 Corinthians 5:7) "For even Christ

our Passover is sacrificed for us." The lamb was spotless, scrutinized, and slain.

B. *Salvation by God's Power (Chapter 13-18)*

1. *Power of God in delivering God's people (chapters 13-14)*

2. *Praise of God for delivering God's people (chapter 15)*

3. *Murmuring to God by God's people (chapter 15-17)*. They begin their three month journey from the Red Sea to Mt. Sinai.

3. Israel at Sinai in Sanctification (Exodus 19-40). Israel is at Sinai almost one year

A. *Sanctified by the Word (Exodus 19-24)*

1. *The Ten Commandments (chapters 19, 20)*.

a. The Mosaic Covenant was a conditional covenant (19:5, 6) unlike the Abrahamic unconditional covenant.

b. The 10 Commandments are kept by loving God and your neighbor.

2. *The Book of the Covenant (chapters 21-24)*. "The Book of the Covenant" 24:7.

These

laws elaborate and apply the 10 Commandments to every area of life. Exodus

22:1-4

expanded on the 6th and 8th commandments.
