1. The Trouble of Storms (4:35-41)

- A. Storms arise when we obey (4:35)
- B. Storms suddenly arise (4:36-37)
- C. Storms can draw out our unbelief (4:38-40)
- D. Storms should teach us more about Jesus (4:41)

2. The Trouble of Demons (5:1-20)

- A. Satan wants to destroy us (5:1-5)
 - 1. Personally
 - 2. Relationally
- B. Christ wants to deliver us (5:6-20)
 - 1. There is a battle (5:6-12)
 - 2. Christ wins the battle (5:13-20)

3. The Trouble of Sickness (5:21-34)

- A. Sickness touches all (5:21-30)
 - 1. The contrast
 - 2. The comparison
- B. Christ is touched with the feelings of our infirmities (31-34)
 - 1. Faith touches Christ
 - 2. Christ heals or gives grace (2 Cor 12:9)

4. The Trouble of Death (5:35-43)

- A. We can't let death stop us from believing (5:35-36)
- B. Our saved loved ones who have died are asleep (their bodies) (5:37-39)
- C. Our saved loved ones who know Christ will awake (5:40-41)
