**A. Christ is the Revealer (1:4b)**

**1. God revealed Himself to Adam and Eve "Let there be light"**

(God reveals Himself to us through nature: Ps 19:1)

**2. God reveals Himself in spite of darkness (1:5) Because of Adam's Fall**

**3. God reveals Himself by witnesses (1:6-9). Why Should We Be Witnesses?**

**A. Because We Have Been Sent (1:6)**

- 1) John is contrasted with Christ
- 2) John was sent

**B. Because We Are Witnesses (1:7)**

- 1) John was a witness about the Light
- 2) John was an instrument of belief

**C. Because of The Greatest of Our Savior (1:8)**

- 1) We are not great (1:8a)
- 2) But we have a great Savior (1:8b)

**D. Because Christ Helps Us Witness (1:9)**

- 1) Sinners are blinded by Satan (2 Cor 4:3-6)
- 2) We can't open their eyes (1 Cor 2:14)
- 3) Christ enlightens sinners through His Word and Spirit (1:19-51)
  - a. John did not promote himself (1:19-28)
  - b. John bore witness of the Light (1:29-34)
  - c. Christ enlightens sinners (1:35-51)
