Acts 2:42-47
(Sunday, April 22)

Where Did the Gospel Spread?

- A. The Spread of the Gospel in Jerusalem (Acts 1-7)
- B. The Spread of the Gospel in Judaea and Samaria (Acts 8-12)
- C. The Spread of the Gospel to the Uttermost Part of the earth (Acts 13-28)

Luke *first* gives the immediate results of Peter's preaching when people went to church for the first time (Acts 2:37-41)

- 1. Conviction
- 2. Salvation
- 3. Baptism
- 4. Church membership

Next, Luke gives the continued results of Peter's preaching which are the five ongoing ministries. What happened after the first day people went to church? (Acts 2:42-47)

- 1. Teaching God's Word
- 2. Fellowshiping with God's People
- 3. Worshiping of God
- 4. Servicing in God's Work
- 5. Evangelizing the Unsaved:
 - A. This was the result of the first four ministries or of a healthy church.
 - B. They praised God and had favor with all the people (Matthew 22:36-39)

How Did The Gospel Spread?

1. Confrontation Evangelism:

- A. Jesus and Nicodemus (John 3) and the Samaritan woman (John 4)
- B. Philip and the Ethiopian (Acts 8)

2. Event Evangelism:

- A. The unsaved came to church (1 Corinthians 14:23-40)
- B. Cornelius invited unsaved family and friends to church (Acts 10)

3. Friendship Evangelism

- A. Andrew brought his brother Peter to Christ (John 1:40-42)
- B. The first church taught God's Word, fellowshiped, worshiped, and served (Acts 2)
Then the "the Lord added to the church such as should be saved."
